

## **Non-licensed Asbestos Works Training.**

### **Who should attend?**

Anyone who knowingly disturbs asbestos containing materials (ACMs) during the course of their work or anyone who supervises such people.

### **Course aims**

To understand the risks from asbestos exposure; to be better aware of typical ACMs and where you might find them within properties; to have an understanding of key legislation within the current regulations; to know what works are licensed and which are non-licensed and what that really means; to be able to determine whether a task is licensed or not; to be able to determine when non-licensed works are notifiable to the HSE and what other legal requirements are triggered when carrying out Notifiable Non-licensed Works (NNLW); to know what RPE & PPE must be worn and the fundamentals of non-licensed asbestos works

### **The Training**

The training is the framework for non-licensed asbestos works; the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012 states that you must be competent to work on non-licensed asbestos; the training alone does not make you competent; competency comes from receiving the training and following the approved guidance used in the training – every time.

A full days training as described below, the task(s) related training in the afternoon session are tailored to meet your needs.

Typical non-licensed tasks are:

- Cement sheets & rainwater goods
- Cement soffit
- Vinyl floor tiles & adhesive
- Artex

Drilling

- Cements
- Vinyl floor tiles
- Artex
- Asbestos Insulation Board
